QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE VICE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES (Write-in Candidate)

Before the filing officer accepts a declaration of candidacy, the filing officer must read the constitutional and statutory requirements to the candidate or the candidate's designated agent, and the candidate or the designated agent must state whether the candidate fulfills the requirements. If the candidate or the designated agent indicates that the candidate does not qualify, the filing officer shall decline the declaration of candidacy. Refer to Utah Code Annotated § 20A-9-601.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

Utah Constitution, Article II, Section 1

- Natural born citizen of the United States.
- 35 years of age upon taking the oath of office.
- Resident of the United States for 14 years upon taking the oath of office.

Utah Code Annotated § 20A-9-201

- Pay a filing fee of \$500.00.

Utah Code Annotated §20A-9-202

- Submit a letter from a presidential candidate who has qualified for the general election ballot that names the individual as a joint-ticket running mate as a vice president candidate.
