- 35 years of age upon taking the oath of office
- Resident of the United States for 14 years upon taking the oath of office.

- Pay a filing fee of \$500.
- Submit a letter from the presidential candidate that names the individual as a joint-ticket running mate as a vice presidential candidate. § 20A-9-601
