IMPORTANT NOTES

8/5 - Last day to send/mail absentee ballots to active registered voters

8/11 - If a UOCAVA individual is not registered to vote, they may submit an FPCA and FWAB to register to vote and submit their ballot.

8/12 - A UOCAVA voter must send their ballot no later than 12:01 a.m. (voter's local time), or the ballot must be received by the election official not later than the close of polls.

8/12 - 8/19 - A candidate shall file their declaration of candidacy or nomination petition (RCV) during the office hours (*No sooner than the second Tuesday in August and no later than the Third Tuesday in August*).

8/18 - 8/25 - Voter must submit an affidavit to resolve a signature discrepancy on a mail ballot (i.e., "cure letter") by 5:00 p.m. three days before the canvass.

8/22 - 8/29 - Last day that a candidate may request a recount within three days after the primary election canvass is completed. (Within 3 days after the primary election canvass. 5:00 pm deadline)

DEFINITIONS

Canvass: the review of election returns and the official declaration of election results by the board of canvassers.

Board of Canvassers: the entities established by Sections 20A-4-301 and 20A-4-306 to canvass election returns.*

11/3 - If a UOCAVA individual is not registered to vote, they may submit an FPCA and FWAB to register to vote and submit their ballot.

11/4 - A UOCAVA voter must send their ballot no later than 12:01 a.m. (voter's local time), or the ballot must be received by the election official not later than the close of polls..

11/6 - 11/13 - Voter must submit an affidavit to resolve a signature discrepancy on a mail ballot (i.e., "cure letter") by 5:00 p.m. three days before the day the canvass begins.

11/17 - 11/24 - If a local initiative was approved by the voters, the initiative takes effect unless otherwise specified in the initiative (5 days after the canvass).

11/18 - 11/25 - Last day that a candidate may request a recount (Within 7 days after the canvass, before 5 PM).
